Over the past six months, God has continued to work in miraculous ways through Africa Harvest of Hope. From making the children at Harvest of Hope Nyumba Ya Watoto feel more at home each day to the introduction of Tanzania Specialty Coffee and Kili-Vanilla in our online store to fund our ministry efforts, we continue to see Him partnering with us in our mission to minister to the orphans in Tanzania. As we remain steadfast in following God's guidance, we invite you to join us in our partnership.

As we continue to expand our outreach programs, we need reliable transportation large enough for the 24 children currently residing in our Children's Homes. The village of Mtakuja often experiences inclement weather, frequently making the roads muddy and challenging to navigate. As a result, a four-wheel drive vehicle will be necessary to traverse the terrain effectively and ensure safe transportation. We have set a budget goal of \$15,000 to obtain a suitable van. Your generous support towards acquiring a van will facilitate our transportation needs and enable us to continue our mission of providing safety for the children under our care.

Government officials visit the Children's Homes annually, recently inquiring about constructing a playground and multi-purpose room. Among our upcoming projects, Africa Harvest of Hope aims to fulfill the requirements of the social workers and provide a playground for the children, consisting of a merry-go-round, monkey bars, and swings. This project will enable the children to experience the joys of outdoor play in a secure environment, complementing the grass field where they often play. To achieve this, we have set a budget goal of \$2,500. Your generous contributions will play a vital role in making this vision a reality, ensuring our ministry is in line with the Tanzanian government and enriching the lives of the children we serve.

However, our biggest upcoming project is constructing the multi-purpose room. This facility will take on many functions, primarily serving as a chapel, dining hall, and recreational space. Our heart is that this facility will serve as a chapel for church services and Bible studies, safely opening our doors to those in the village of Mtakuja. It will also serve as a dining hall and meeting room for the children at Harvest of Hope Nyumba Ya Watoto, enabling them to eat and fellowship amongst one another as one family. Additionally, this facility will feature an awning for an outdoor kitchen, preserving Tanzanian culture and customs. With a budget goal of \$60,000, we aim to fulfill this vision, fostering spiritual growth and community engagement within the village of Mtakuja.

With your continued support, we can turn the vision God has instilled within us into reality. Together, we can ensure safe transportation for our children, offer them the joy of outdoor play in a secure environment, and provide a multifunctional facility that cultivates a sense of familial community. Your support is not just a donation — it is a testament of compassion and hope to the children we serve, ultimately reflecting the love and goodness of God.
